What are the categories of nomination?

Outstanding Project or Program

Career Achievement

What is an eligible Outstanding Project or Program?

Any program that has taken place during the last two years or an on-going program that has made a significant impact to children in Connecticut at the local, regional, and/or state level.

Who is eligible for Career Achievement?

Any person or group/organization that has had a significant impact on library service to children in Connecticut at the local, regional, and/or state level.

What does the winner receive?

An award and recognition at the CLA Annual Conference on April 30th at the Mystic Marriott.
